Don't get caught out. Read our tips about how to chat online.

Texting within the group

1. Make the group size between six and eight. There may be better ways for larger groups to stay in touch.
2. It's important to check what you write before you press send.
3. If something annoys you, wait before you answer.
4. Remember, everybody in the group can read your texts. Pick your group with care.
5. If you want a private chat with one or two members, create a new group.
6. Don't send thirty or more texts in a rush. People will probably start to ignore you.
7. Check you're sending things to the right group.

Chatting within the group

1. Chatting online is a great way to catch up with friends living in another country.
2. There may be a slight delay before people speak. Don't jump in. Give people time. Don't all talk at once.
3. Online chats can be tiring. We suggest no more than ninety minutes.
4. Watch those annoying habits like sniffing or paper rustling! Make sure you're in a quiet place so everybody can hear.
